



Have items to recycle that aren't collected curbside?

Check out the local drop-off locations for the following items:

PAINT

* RepcoLite Paint accepts wet (latex only) paint for \$3 per can. Alternatively, add kitty litter to the can, let it dry out and discard in trash.

ELECTRONICS

* Best Buy accepts most large electronics for a fee. Accepts electronic/cables/phone cords at its Customer Service Desk.

* Padnos Recycling will buy large appliances, accepts large electronics for a fee.

BATTERIES/LIGHTBULBS

* Alkaline batteries (only) recycled at each Tri-Community Municipal Hall (beginning in July).

* Batteries Plus Bulbs accepts any kind of battery and lightbulbs free of charge. Exceptions: There is a \$1/lb. charge for alkaline batteries over 5 lbs. and fluorescents are \$0.50 per foot.

* Lowe's accepts compact fluorescent lightbulbs and cell phones at the Customer Service Desk.

PLASTIC BAGS

* White plastic grocery bags (not produce bags) can be recycled at the entrances of Meijer, Family Fare, D&W, Target. Best to bring a reusable one and skip the plastic bag entirely.

MEDICATIONS AND SHARPS

* Needles & sharps in the appropriate container accepted by Walgreens.

* Medications (includes liquids & ointments) can be placed in drop box at Douglas Police Department.

PLANTER POTS

* Plastic growing/planting containers (individuals & flats) can be returned to participating Meijer and Home Depot garden centers (look for signage).

EVERYTHING ELSE

* Terracycle.com - Based in New Jersey. Purchase *No Waste Boxes* for flexible produce bags, chip bags and everything else you never knew could be recycled.
