1. <u>Review of Draft Zoning Ordinance</u>

Jirousek gave a brief overview of the new draft of the zoning ordinance and gave an overview of the changes that were made. He also noted that changes are highlighted in either yellow or green. Helmrich requested that the review be done page by page, to which Ihle agreed and asked that the Commissioners conduct informal votes on any disagreements to keep the meeting moving at a steady pace.

Commissioners reviewed Articles 1-7 and asked for clarification, explanation, requirements, and reworkings of many items including; site plan and condo checklists, consistency in abbreviations between the draft and the zoning map, Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs), agrotourism regulations, formatting consistency across tables, guidelines for duplexes and townhomes, minimum square footage for residential dwellings, water body classifications, front yard specifications, commercial building height restrictions, primary siding materials, housing style options and their minimum requirements, garage orientation requirements, accommodations, mixed-use zoning, distinctions between grocery, convenience, and retail stores, setback requirements, decorative facades, overlay



districts, FEMA floodplain maps, flag poles, shipping container regulations, and private road stipulations.
